Glass artist, Lea de Wit, creates sculptures, wall hangings, and vessels that delight and inspire. She has received instruction at Scuola del Vetro, Abate Zanetti, in Murano, Italy, at Red Deer College in Canada, at the Corning Museum of Glass in Corning, New York, and at Haystack Mountain School of Crafts in Deer Isle, Maine. Last summer, she received a scholarship to study at the Penland School of Crafts in North Carolina. She has studied under Italian glassblowing masters, Elio Quarisa and Davide Salvatore, and renowned glass sculpture artist, Karen Willenbrink-Johnsen. Her passion for the medium shows in her attention to detail. Her work is on display in galleries and private collections nationwide.
